Richard Yetsenga appointed Chief Economist

ANZ today appointed Richard Yetsenga Chief Economist reporting to Managing Director Markets Shayne Collins.

Mr Yetsenga joined ANZ in 2011 and has been Acting Chief Economist since March 2016. Prior to this he was Head of Financial Markets Research at ANZ and has held senior economic research roles at HSBC, Deutsche Bank and the Australian Government.

ANZ Managing Director Markets Shayne Collins said: "Richard's vast economics experience in financial markets both here in Australia and across the region makes him ideally qualified to lead ANZ's research team.

"Since taking on the acting role of Chief Economist he has made a strong contribution to the team through his values-led leadership, as well as having a commercial impact on the bank's broader business," Mr Collins said.
