David Plank appointed Head of Australian Economics

ANZ today announced that David Plank will join as Head of Australian Economics reporting to Richard Yetsenga, ANZ Chief Economist.

Mr Plank joins ANZ from Deutsche Bank, where he held the positions of Head of Fixed Income and Credit Research Asia Pacific and Head of Macro Research and Strategy Australia & New Zealand.

Prior to this he worked for Bankers Trust in a number of economist and strategy roles before it merged with Deutsche Bank in 1999.

ANZ Chief Economist Richard Yetsenga said: "David's extensive experience, quality of analysis and strong reputation makes him the ideal person to lead our Australian Economics team. He is a well-respected economist, his analysis will be highly valued by our clients and he will integrate well with our market strategy offerings."
