Sanjay Mathur appointed Chief Economist for Southeast Asia and India

ANZ today announced the appointment of Sanjay Mathur as Chief Economist, Southeast Asia and India, reporting to Khoon Goh, ANZ's Head of Asia Research.

Mr Mathur joins from Royal Bank of Scotland where he was Head of Economics Research (Asia ex-Japan) leading research teams across economics, foreign exchange, rates and credit. Prior to this he held senior economic roles at Barclays and UBS.

At ANZ Mr Mathur will be responsible for providing macroeconomic analysis and insight on key Asian markets with a particular focus on Indonesia, Malaysia, Thailand and India.
